While Milan is exposing the best of Italian design, we are proposing a small exhibition, dedicated to a quite intimist aspect of day to day life; the domestic green, that is that bit of leftover nature that we look for as shelter and comfort in the metropolitan life, on the terraces, on the balconies, in the small gardens that keep sprouting from the roofs and the courtyards of the city.

The exhibition dressing was curated by Arch. Marco Bay.

Pieces of furniture by several authors are exposed: from Branzi to Kagan, Albini, Aulenti, La Pietra, Bay etc. and a unique piece by the sculptor Consagra.

David Hicks 's two wash drawings remind us a little the "Arcimboldo" with his triumph of the greens, while Consonni's delicate acquarello proposes an almost Japanese way of feeling the nature and Sangregorio's sculptures do not describe stones and wood but they use their matter force.
